As our eyes age, close-up vision can become blurry, a condition called presbyopia

Simple things like reading, texting, or checking a label may become harder without holding objects farther away or relying on reading glasses.

It's not just you.



About **9 in 10** adults over age 45 in the US have presbyopia, per the American Optometric Association.

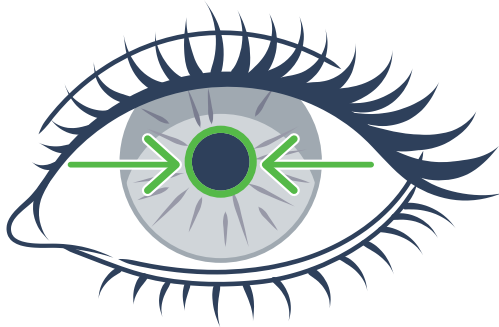


**Instead of surgery, such as

step you can take.**

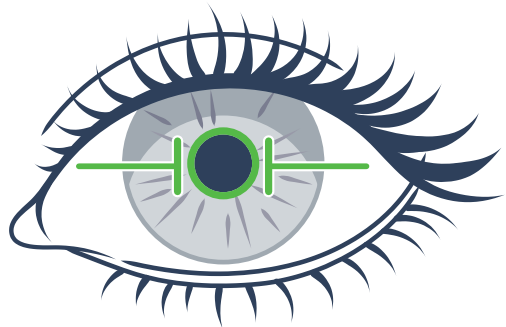
YUVEZZI is an eye drop for blurry close-up vision

YUVEZZI combines two proven medicines that work together to improve close-up vision:

- 1 **Carbachol** helps your pupils get smaller (or “**constrict**”), so it’s easier to focus up close



- 2 **Brimonidine** helps keep your pupils from getting too large (or “**dilating**”)

YUVEZZI may cause temporary blurry, dim, or dark vision. If you experience this, avoid driving, using machinery, and participating in hazardous activities. Use caution when night driving and in other activities in low light.

In medical studies:

YUVEZZI worked just as well over time

YUVEZZI can also help improve reading speed

Presbyopia can make you squint or strain your eyes to see close up. This may slow down how fast you're able to read. But people using YUVEZZI in medical studies had **6× greater improvement in reading** vs those who did not receive YUVEZZI.‡

YUVEZZI was studied in the world's largest and longest presbyopia safety study

The most common side effects in the study were:

- Headache (16% of patients)
- Eye irritation upon use (14% of patients)
- Eye pain upon use (7% of patients)
- Impaired vision (6% of patients)

Most side effects were generally mild, didn't last long, and went away on their own.

- Headache rates were generally low (fewer than 2 out of 10 patients) and mostly stopped after the first week of use
- Nearly 9 out of 10 people were able to keep using YUVEZZI without stopping because of side effects for the full year of the study

People taking YUVEZZI had no treatment-related serious side effects in a 1-year safety study.

Call your doctor right away if you suddenly have flashes of light, floaters, or vision loss.

Do not let the tip of the vial touch your eye, eyelid, or any other surface.

Most side effects were generally mild, didn't last long, and went away on their own.

YUVEZZI is a fuss-less eye drop that can be used your way:



On its own instead of reading glasses

OR



With contacts or glasses you use to see far away

Directions for use with contacts

- Remove your contacts before using YUVEZZI
- Wait 10 minutes before putting them back in your eyes

Directions for use with other eye drops

- Allow 5 minutes between them
- Talk to your eye doctor about which drop you should use first

Select Important Safety Information

The most common side effects of YUVEZZI are headache, impaired vision, and eye pain and/or eye irritation upon use.

YUVEZZI is as easy as one and done—just one drop per eye, once a day

- ① Twist off the top of the plastic vial
- ② Squeeze the vial to release 1 drop in each eye
- ③ Throw away the vial (even if it is not empty)

Do not let the tip of the vial touch your eye, eyelid, or any other surface.

To protect from light, store any unused vials in their original foil pouch until ready for use.

Convenient single-use vials

- Travel-ready at all times with no refrigeration required
- Get a complete month in one box, so no mid-month refills needed

Not sure what to ask at your eye doctor appointment?

Use this tear sheet to help guide your conversation and understand what options may be best for you.

Considering eye drops for your presbyopia (blurry close-up vision due to age)?

Here are some questions to ask your eye doctor to see if this is right for you.

What is important to you when selecting an option that helps your blurry close-up vision?

Check all that apply:

- Lasts a typical 8-hour workday
- Only needs to be used once a day
- Has been studied for at least 1 year
- Doesn't need to be refrigerated
- Doesn't require extra items to keep track of
- Allows me to stay active
- Doesn't require surgery

As you consider your options, it's important to tell your eye doctor about your medical history.

Do any of these apply to you?

- Eye disease or inflamed iris (iritis)
- Retinal disease
- Depression
- Low blood pressure
- Circulation problems
- Pregnant or nursing
